AVT Natural Products Limited, held at 11.00 A.M. on Wednesday, the 10th August 2016 at Hotel Vestin Park, 'Palkhi Hall, 39, Montieth Road, Egmore, Chennai – 600 008

I, V Suresh, Practising Company Secretary, have been appointed by the Board of Directors of M/s. AVT Natural Products Limited (the Company) as a Scrutinizer for the purpose of scrutinizing the remote e-voting/ voting through Ballot Papers at the AGM venue and ascertaining the requisite majority, as per the provisions of Section 108 of the Companies Act, 2013 (the Act) read with Rule 20 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014 and amendments thereto in respect of the resolutions contained in the notice to the 30th Annual General Meeting (AGM) of the members of the Company, held at 11.00 A.M. on Wednesday, the 10th August 2016 at Hotel Vestin Park, 'Palkhi Hall, 39, Montieth Road, Egmore, Chennai – 600 008.

The Notice dated 30th May 2016 along with statement setting out material facts under Section 102 of the Act were sent to the Shareholders in respect of the below mentioned resolutions passed at the Annual General Meeting of the Company.

The Public Advertisement with respect to dispatch of notices and conducting of voting through electronic means was published in an English newspaper "The Business Line" and in a vernacular newspaper "Makkal Kural" having wide circulation, in their respective editions dated 18th July 2016.

The management of the Company is responsible to ensure the compliance with the requirements of the Companies Act, 2013 and the Rules relating to voting through electronic means on the resolutions contained in the Notice of 30th Annual General Meeting (AGM) of the members of the Company. My responsibility as a Scrutinizer for the e-voting process is restricted to presenting a Scrutinizer's Report on the votes cast "in favour" or "against" or "abstained", in respect of the resolutions stated below, based on the reports generated from the e-voting system provided by M/s. Central Depository Services (India) Limited ('CDSL'), the authorized agency to provide e-voting facilities, engaged by the Company.



The Company had also provided for voting through Ballot Papers at the AGM venue at the 30th Annual General Meeting, to the shareholders who had not cast their vote earlier through remote e-voting facility.

The members of the Company as on the "cut-off" date i.e. August 03, 2016 were entitled to vote on the resolutions (items no. 1 to 6 as set out in the notice of the 30th AGM of the Company.)

Further to the above, I submit my report as under:-

Remote E-voting:

- The e-voting period remained open from Sunday, August 7, 2016 (9.00 a.m.) to Tuesday, August 9, 2016 (5.00 p.m.) (both days inclusive).
- The votes cast under remote e-voting facility were thereafter unblocked in presence of two witnesses who were not in employment of the Company.
- iii. The Corporate members who had participated in the remote e-voting had provided scanned copy of the resolution passed at their Board of Directors Meeting for authorization to exercise their votes through e-voting.

Voting through Ballot Papers at the AGM venue:

- The Company had provided the facility for voting through ballot paper at the AGM and members, who have not cast their vote by remote e-voting were allowed to exercise their right to vote at the meeting.
- ii. The Ballot papers in Form MGT-12 as per Section 109(5) of the Act and rule 21(1)(c) of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014 were distributed to the shareholders present. The shareholders cast their votes in the ballot box kept at convenient places in the venue.
- iii. The locked ballot box was subsequently opened before me, in presence of two witnesses who were not in employment of the Company and Ballot papers were diligently scrutinized. The Ballot papers were reconciled with the records maintained by the Company and the authorizations/proxies lodged with the Company.
- iv. The ballot papers of 2 shareholders (81 shares) were marked as invalid.

Thereafter, the consolidated results containing, inter alia, list of Equity Shareholders, who voted "for", "against" or "abstained", in respect of the each of the resolutions that were put to vote, were generated from the e-voting website of M/s.
